Call to Order at 1:35pm

 Approval of Minutes - General Meeting: October 17, 2023. 1st Melissa Monday, 2nd Alyssa Rudel. Motion carries, minutes approved.

Comments from Principal Powell

- Will follow up with the district regarding water bottle filling stations.
- Pastries with Parents (3rd 6th gr) 2/21 at 8:15am re: CAASPP state testing support.
- Prop 28 for Arts + Music = new funds to support music and arts. Lakewood has been granted \$50,845 (recurring annual grant, funds must be used within 3 years). Funds will first be utilized to repair and/or replace music instruments. Remaining balance to be allocated as 80% staffing and personnel, 19% materials and supplies (one-time fee items),and 1% reserve. Input received from staff and PTA board include: absorption of art teacher, pep band after school, photography teacher, music and art during intersessions, additional time for pianist, music teacher for lower grades, dance, multicultural dancing, Gallo for all grade levels, culinary, foreign language.
 - PTA board specifically requests absorption of art teacher to relieve parental support and fundraising needs, plus sign language lessons for all classes (to be even more inclusive of our DHH students).
 - Suggest also reaching out to MJC and local colleges to see if there are any arts/music teachers that need volunteer or classroom hours.

Budget: current bank balance is \$57,002.36, moving into heavy expenditure season (field trips and drama expenses happening now plus final expenses on audio equipment for media center).

- Lighting in media center needs to be replaced, district will pay.

- REMINDER: Budget reserve = half of annual expenses plus our art teacher's full salary.
- Costs continue to rise. PTA Board will need to assess when setting next year's budget.
